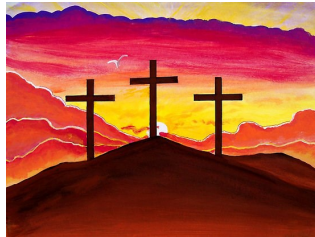

Baptism

Why does God instruct us to be baptised?

Baptism is the first act of obedience in service to the Lord. **Anyone** can be baptised after salvation; it takes **no** special talents or effort.

Jesus set the example Himself by submitting to baptism **before** He began His public ministry.



Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11; Luke 3:21-22

What is the purpose of baptism?

Romans 6:1-7 (specifically verses 3-4) shows the two purposes of baptism. It **pictures** the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

It is a public testimony of the new convert's identification with Jesus Christ through the death, burial, and resurrection which is how he was saved. It **identifies** him with the Lord Jesus Christ.

Who should be baptised?

The clearest case of an individual's baptism in the Bible is the Ethiopian eunuch in *Acts 8:26-39*. In verse 36, the eunuch asked, ". . . *what doth hinder me to be baptised?*" Phillip then answered with the condition of baptism in verse 37, ". . . *If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest.*" Then the eunuch's response sealed the matter, "*I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God*".

The only requirements for baptism are the requirements for salvation found in *Romans 10:9-10*.

Complete trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour. Confession that He is Lord and Saviour.

If you are saved and considering baptism; we will be having a baptismal service early in 2017. Please speak to the Pastor or any of the elders.
